- (a) how many companies or individuals reported known or suspected contaminated sites in 2012–2013 and in the first half of 2013–2014;
- (b) how many companies or individuals have been fined for failure to report a contaminated site within the requisite time periods in the last five years; and
- (c) who were they, where were the sites and what was the penalty in each case?

  - (v) Paraburdoo Nursing Post;
  - (vi) Regional telehealth facilities in the north; and
  - (vii) Aged care facility in Carnarvon?
