1. Meeting of Assembly

The Assembly met at 9.00 a.m. pursuant to adjournment.

2. Petitions

Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Act 2003 – Mr M.P. Murray presented a petition from 313 persons requesting that the Legislative Assembly call for an independent review of the *Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Act 2003* by a parliamentary committee, and also that it supports GM-free farming and urges the Government to introduce farmer protection legislation to compensate farmers who suffer economic loss due to GM contamination (P. 286).

Disability Services Commission – Mr P.C. Tinley presented a petition from 92 persons asking the Legislative Assembly to reverse the proposed cuts to the Disability Services Commission Accommodation Services and to ensure that individuals currently in the DSC Group Homes, their families and guardians are given the choice to stay with their current service provider and to recognise and deploy the skills and commitment of the 500 accommodation staff in implementing a National Disability Insurance Scheme into the future (P. 287).
