- (c) the average daily percentage of patients transferred from St. Johns Ambulance to emergency department staff inside thirty minutes; and
- (d) the median time taken to transfer from St. Johns Ambulance to emergency department staff?

4183. Ms J. Farrer to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Child Protection:

I refer to the women's refuge at Djarindjin community, and I ask:

- (a) is the Minister aware that the refuge is facing imminent closure due to being defunded by the Federal Government;
- (b) will the Minister commit to lobbying, seeking and securing funds to ensure the refuge remains open;
- (c) will the Minister meet with women and leaders in Djarindjin community to discuss solutions to ensure the refuge remains open; and
- (d) if yes to (c), when will you meet?

4184. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

I refer to State Government funded School Attendance Officers, and I ask:

- (a) how many Attendance Officers are currently employed in the Kimberley;
- (b) where are each of those officers located;
- (c) how many Attendance Officers are employed in Halls Creek;
- (d) is the Minister aware of Federally funded Attendance Officers in Halls Creek; and
- (e) if yes to (d), can the Minister explain the difference in roles between Federally funded Attendance Officers and State funded Attendance Officers?

I refer to the Minister's response arising from Corrective Services Estimates of 11 June 2015 and information provided by way of Supplementary Information A63. Noting the Minister's response concerning the definition of consultants and the provision of the names of four consultants, I request additional information as follows:

- (f) what is the success rate of the Department's T1 House Services Reunification Program?
