**Questions listed for this sitting: -**

**5825. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister for Lands:**

I refer to South African Western Australian Pastoral Co (SAWA) clearing native vegetation without authorisation, and I ask:

- (a) how many times has SAWA been found guilty of clearing native vegetation without authorisation;
- (b) how will the Minister ensure that this company does not continue this illegal behaviour; and
- (c) will the Minister ban this company from continuing to holding Pastoral leases because of the company's ongoing illegal behaviour?

**5826. Ms L.L. Baker to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning:**

I refer to the land south of Bardon Park in Maylands, owned by the Western Australian Planning Commission, and ask is the Minister aware of the Aboriginal significance of this site, including the many fresh water springs in this area known as "Malgamongup"?

**5827. Ms L.L. Baker to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning:**

I refer to the containment program which is underway on the land south of Bardon Park in Maylands, owned by the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC), and ask:

- (a) can the Minister please provide a record of the WAPC's expenditure on this land annually since 2008, specifically relating to environmental restoration in weed control and vegetation (excluding any amount spent on cycleway/footpath);
- (b) has the Minister visited this site to see the extent of the weed infestation, and if so, when;
- (c) does the Minister acknowledge the need for urgent action before an explosion of weeds occur; and
- (d) will the Minister commit to ongoing funding to get on top of the weed infestation?

**5828. Ms L.L. Baker to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning:**

I refer to the weed mapping exercise which has commenced on the land south of Bardon Park in Maylands, owned by the Western Australian Planning Commission, to identify the extent of the weed infestation, and ask:

- (a) what is the timeframe for the completion of the weed mapping exercise;
- (b) once the weed mapping exercise is completed and advice has been sought as to an appropriate treatment program, will the Minister commit to allocating funds and schedule a program to eradicate the site of invasive weeds;
- (c) what is the timeframe for the program in (b); and
- (d) if not to (b), why not?

**5829. Mr W.J. Johnston to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to your attendance at Cinefest in the State electoral district of Vasse on 24 August 2016, and I ask:

- (a) How did you travel to Busselton for this event; and
- (b) If you travelled by air, please advise:
  - (i) which plane did you use;
  - (ii) how much did the travel cost;
  - (iii) who travelled with you; and

- (iv) at what time did your flight depart from Perth and what time did it depart from Busselton?

**5830. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister for Corrective Services:**

I refer to the Derby's West Kimberley Regional Prison, and I ask:

- (a) at full capacity, how many prisoners can be held at any one time;
- (b) how many prisoners are currently being held there;
- (c) how many staff are currently employed based at the Derby Prison:
  - (i) of these staff, how many are Aboriginal; and
  - (ii) of these staff, how many are female; and
- (d) how many staff are needed to operate the prison when functioning at full capacity?

**5831. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister for Corrective Services:**

I refer to the Broome Regional Prison, and I ask:

- (a) can the Minister please explain the philosophy for the site;
- (b) does the Minister intend to increase the use of the facility to its full capacity;
- (c) at full capacity, how many prisoners can be held at any one time;
- (d) how many prisoners are currently being held there;
- (e) will the prison be renovated, refurbished or upgraded;
- (f) what key maintenance issues have been identified;
- (g) when will the improvements to the facility likely to occur;
- (h) what is the estimated cost involved to complete the necessary works on the prison so that it can be used at full capacity;
- (i) were these costs identified in the 2016/2017 budget;
- (j) how many staff are currently employed based at the Broome Prison;
- (k) of these staff, how many are Aboriginal; and
- (l) how many staff are needed to operate the prison when functioning at full capacity?

**5832. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Police:**

I refer to the deployment of five Youth Crime Intervention officers (YCIOs) at Warwick Police, and I ask:

- (a) what are the ranks of these officers;
- (b) what is their role;
- (c) what is the geographical area of their responsibility;
- (d) what are the type, title and duration of any programs which they undertake;
- (e) are these officers deployed full time on activities listed at (d);
- (f) what are their responsibilities under the Young Offenders Act 1994; and
- (g) how many individual youths were dealt with in the last financial year?



**5833. Mr D.A. Templeman to the Minister for Local Government:**

Is the Minister aware that local government planners are also providing private, contracted advice and work for developers, and if so:

- (a) does the Department or Minister acknowledge the conflict of interest concerns this raises; and
- (b) are there any Departmental policies that address such a conflict of interest?
