1. Meeting of Assembly

The Assembly met at 12.00 noon pursuant to adjournment.

2. Brief Ministerial Statements

The Minister for Culture and the Arts on the launch of the *Historical Panoramas: Perth and Fremantle Virtual Tour* project.

The Minister for Agriculture and Food on the detection of the agricultural pest, the Russian Wheat Aphid, in South Australia.

The Minister for Seniors and Volunteering on World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.

3. Road Traffic Legislation Amendment (Disqualification for Life) Bill 2016

Mr R.F. Johnson, pursuant to notice, moved,

That a bill for "An Act to amend the *Road Traffic Act 1974* and the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008.*" be introduced and read a first time.

Question put and passed.

Ordered, That the second reading of the bill be made an Order of the Day for a later stage of the sitting.

That this House condemns the Liberal National Government for its mismanagement of the state training providers resulting in significant job losses, fee increases, reductions in student contact hours and the increasing privatisation of the training sector.
