Kelly presented a petition from 1 person asking the Legislative Assembly to consider allowing turning access to Morley Drive and incorporating it into the proposed roundabout at the intersection of Tonkin Highway and, if this is unworkable, a slip road to facilitate turning left onto Morley Drive from Abbey Street (P. 386).

Rest Stop Toilet Facility on Indian Ocean Drive, Gingin – Mr R.S. Love presented a petition from 247 persons asking the Legislative Assembly to review correspondence from Main Roads to the Wanneroo Roadwise Committee and the Shire of Gingin and liaise with the Department of Parks and Wildlife to provide this basic amenity (P. 387).

 - (4C) A court convicting a person on indictment of an offence against this section must order
 - (a) that the person be permanently disqualified from holding or obtaining a driver's licence, if the incident occasions the death of another person and either
 - (i) the offence is against subsection (1)(a), (ba) or (bb); or
 - (ii) the offence is against subsection (1)(b) and is committed in circumstances of aggravation;

or

(b) that the person be disqualified from holding or obtaining a driver's licence for a period of not less than 2 years, in any other case.

".
