7 receives the Royal Assent;

8 (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9 **3. Appropriation for recurrent services and purposes**

10 The sum of \$297 032 405, being payments of an extraordinary
11 or unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2017
12 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and
13 charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is
14 appropriated for the recurrent services and purposes expressed
15 in Schedule 1.
