3	(1)	The Minister may, by order, modify or suspend the operation of —
5 6		(a) specified provisions of this Act (other than provisions of this Part); or
7 8		(b) specified provisions of regulations made under this Act.
9 10	(2)	The Minister can make an order under subsection (1) only if each of the following conditions is satisfied —
11 12		(a) the order is made while a COVID emergency declaration is in force;
13 14 15		(b) the Minister considers that the order is necessary to deal with consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic.
16 17	(3)	Unless sooner revoked under section 9.65(2), an order made under subsection (1) is revoked at the end of —
18 19 20 21		(a) the last day of the period of 3 months beginning on the day on which the COVID emergency declaration referred to in subsection (2)(a) is revoked or otherwise ceases to have effect; or
22		(b) any earlier day specified in the order.
23 24 25	(4)	The <i>Interpretation Act 1984</i> section 42 applies to an order made under subsection (1) as if the order were regulations made under this Act.
26 27 28 29	(5)	Without limiting the <i>Interpretation Act 1984</i> section 43(7), an order made under subsection (1) may modify or suspend the operation of specified provisions of this Act, or of regulations made under this Act, in relation to all local governments, local governments of
31		a specified class or a specified local government.

2 3 4 5	(1)	A local government may, by resolution*, suspend the operation of a specified local law, or specified provisions of a local law, made by the local government under this Act or any other Act.
6		* Absolute majority required.
7 8	(2)	Subsection (1) applies despite the provisions of any other Act under which a local law is made.
9 10 11	(3)	A local government can make a resolution under subsection (1) only if each of the following conditions is satisfied —
12 13		(a) the resolution is made while a COVID emergency declaration is in force;
14 15 16		(b) the local government considers that the resolution is necessary to deal with consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic.
17 18	(4)	A local government may, by resolution*, revoke a resolution made by it under subsection (1).
19		* Absolute majority required.
20 21	(5)	After making a resolution under subsection (1) or (4), a local government must —
22 23		(a) publish it on the local government's official website; and
24		(b) give a copy of it to the Minister.
25 26	(6)	A resolution made under subsection (1) or (4) takes effect on —
27 28		(a) the day after the day on which it is first published under subsection (5)(a); or
29		(b) any later day specified in the resolution.
