13 14 15 16 17		(1A) Despite subsection (1), the court is not required to declare the person to be a drug trafficker if the court is satisfied that it would be clearly unjust to do so, having regard to the circumstances of the commission of the offence and any other matter the court considers relevant.	
19 20 21		(1B) A court that, because of subsection (1A), does not declare a person to be a drug trafficker must give reasons for its decision not to do so.
