Criminal Code Amendment (Graffiti) Bill 2009

A Bill for

An Act to amend the *The Criminal Code*.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1 **1. Short title**

2 This is the *Criminal Code Amendment (Graffiti) Act 2009*.

3 **2. Commencement**

4 This Act comes into operation as follows —

- 5 (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act
6 receives the Royal Assent;
7 (b) the rest of the Act — on a day fixed by proclamation,
8 and different days may be fixed for different provisions.

9 **3. The Criminal Code amended**

10 This Act amends *The Criminal Code*.

11 **4. Chapter XXIV inserted**

12 After section 215 insert:

13 **Chapter XXIV — Miscellaneous offences**

14 **216. Selling graffiti implements to children**

15 (1) In this section —

16 *graffiti implement* means any of these —

- 17 (a) a can of spray paint;
18 (b) a pen, marker pen, or similar implement,
19 that —
20 (i) has a tip over 6 mm wide; and
21 (ii) contains a fluid that is not water soluble
22 and that is capable of marking a surface.

23 (2) A person who sells a graffiti implement to a child
24 commits an offence and is liable —

- 25 (a) for a first offence, to a fine of \$6 000;
26 (b) for a subsequent offence, to a fine of \$12 000.

1 (3) It is a defence to a charge of an offence under
2 subsection (2) to prove the accused, or a person acting
3 on behalf of the accused, believed on reasonable
4 grounds that the person to whom the implement was
5 sold had reached 18 years of age.

7 **5. Section 445 amended**

8 In section 445 delete “12 months and a fine of \$12 000.” and
9 insert:

10 2 years and a fine of \$24 000.
