A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Heritage of Western Australia Act 1990* to increase the penalties for illegal works upon places entered in the Register of Heritage Places, and for related purposes.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

This Act comes into operation 28 days after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
