CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT (OUT-OF-CONTROL GATHERINGS) BILL 2012 [312-1]

When in committee on the *Criminal Law Amendment (Out-of-Control Gatherings) Bill 2012*:

Clause 4

Hon Giz Watson: To move –

- (5A) In deciding whether to make an order under subsection (5) the court must have regard to the following —
- (a) the offender's means to satisfy any such order having regard to —
 - (i) the offender's income, assets and liabilities; and
 - (ii) the offender's current and prospective employment;
 - (b) the extent to which the offender is likely to be able to satisfy any such order within a reasonable time; and
 - (c) the age of the offender and the impact of the order on the future of the offender.

- (c) the exercise of the powers is reasonable under consideration of all available circumstances of the threat,
