# Western Australia Day (Renaming) Bill 2011

#### A Bill for

An Act to rename Foundation Day to Western Australia Day and accordingly to amend the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972* and the *Minimum Conditions of Employment Act 1993* and for related purposes.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:
