4		This Act comes into operation as follows —
5 6		(a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
7		(b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.
8	3.	Issue and application of moneys
9	(1)	The sum of \$1 934 909 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year beginning on 1 July 2015 and ending on 30 June 2016.
3	(2)	The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the <i>Appropriation (Recurrent 2015-16) Act 2015</i> .

The sum of \$1 934 909 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
