Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 4) 1999

A Bill for

An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund —

- a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 1998 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1997*; and
- a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 1999 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1998*.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 4) 1999*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Appropriation for capital services and purposes

- 5 (1) The sum of \$270 617 088.24 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1997* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
- 10 (2) The sum of \$24 316 297.25 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1998* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital services and purposes expressed in Schedule 2.
