**Petroleum Legislation Amendment (LPG) Bill
2000**

A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Petroleum Retailers Rights And Liabilities Act 1982* and the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act 1983*.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Petroleum Legislation Amendment (LPG) Act 2000*.

5 **2. Commencement**

This Act comes into operation on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Principal Act

4. Section 3 amended

10 Section 3 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by inserting after “petrol” in the definition of “**motor fuel**” the following —

“ , liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), ”.

5. Section 4 amended

15 Section 4 of the principal Act is amended —

(1) In subsection (1) by —

“ (a) inserting after “persons)” the following —

20 “ purchase motor fuel from a supplier other than his primary supplier or ”; and

(b) inserting after the phrase “which he is” the following —

“ hereby ”; and

- (2) In subsection (5) by inserting after “agreement” the following —

- (a) requires the tenant to purchase motor fuel of any kind or grade exclusively from the landlord or primary supplier;
