Inquiry into the potential environmental contribution of recreational hunting systems

The Standing Committee on Public Administration will be holding its first public hearings from **9:00am on Wednesday, 18 June 2014**. The Committee will be taking evidence from:

- (i) Department of Lands
- (ii) Department of Parks and Wildlife
- (iii) Department of Agriculture and Food
- (iv) Western Australia Police

in relation to the above inquiry.

The hearings will be held at the Legislative Council Committee Office, Ground floor, 18 - 32 Parliament Place, West Perth, and will be open to the general public.

The Committee received more than 400 submissions, all of which are available online at www.parliament.wa.gov.au/pub.
