#### SYNOPSIS OF BILLS

The following synopsis of Bills dealt with by the Legislative Assembly this week, is intended only to give a brief outline of the purpose of each Bill at the second reading stage of the Bill and the stages it was dealt with in the Legislative Assembly.

#### **Reserves Bill 2023**

(Minister for Lands) (No. 134)

The purpose of this bill is to excise certain areas of land from class A reserves; and to amend the classification of certain reserved land; and to amend the purpose of certain reserved land.

Second reading, debated and agreed.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

## **Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Application Bill 2023**

(Minister for Health) (No. 131)

The purpose of this bill is to apply the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law* (with modifications) as a law of the State; and to repeal the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (WA) Act 2010*; and to make consequential amendments to other Acts; and for related purposes.

Second reading, debated and adjourned.

## **State Superannuation Amendment Bill 2023**

(Treasurer) (No. 136)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the State Superannuation Act 2000.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and debate adjourned.

#### Western Australian Marine Amendment Bill 2023

(Minister assisting the Minister for Transport) (No. 135)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the Western Australian Marine Act 1982 and to make consequential amendments to other Acts.

Consideration in detail and amended.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

## Planning and Development Amendment Bill 2023

(Minister for Planning) (No. 132)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Planning and Development Act 2005*; and make consequential and related amendments to other Acts; and repeal the *Power of Entry and Inspection Regulations*.

Second reading debated and agreed.

Consideration in detail.
