### [Electoral Amendment \(Names of Registered Political Parties\) Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for Electoral Affairs) (No.192)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Electoral Act 1907.

Introduced; read a first time.

Second reading agreed.

Consideration in detail.

Bill read a third time and presented to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### [Road Traffic \(Authorisation to Drive\) Amendment \(Driving Restrictions\) Bill 2024](#)

(Minister Assisting the Minister for Transport) (No.193)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008.

Introduced; read a first time.

Second reading agreed.

Consideration in detail.

Bill read a third time and presented to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### [Young Offenders and Prisons Legislation Amendment Bill 2024](#)

(Attorney General) (No.173)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Prisons Act 1981 and the Young Offenders Act 1994.

Second reading agreed.

Bill read a third time and presented to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### [Control of Vehicles \(Off-road Areas\) Amendment Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for Local Government) (No.165)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Control of Vehicles (Off-road Areas) Act 1978.

Second reading agreed.

Consideration in detail.

Bill read a third time and presented to the Legislative Council for concurrence.

### [Reserves Bill 2024](#)

(Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Planning) (No.171)

The purpose of this Bill is to reserve land for the purposes of national parks, conservation parks and other purposes; and to change the classification or purpose of certain reserves; and to excise certain areas of land from reserves; and to effect other changes to land; and to amend the Reserves (National Parks, Conservation Parks, Nature Reserves and Other Reserves) Act 2004 consequentially.

Second reading; adjourned debate.
