## SYNOPSIS OF BILLS

*The following synopsis of Bills dealt with by the Legislative Assembly this week, is intended only to give a brief outline of the purpose of each Bill at the second reading stage of the Bill and the stages it was dealt with in the Legislative Assembly.*

### **Workers Compensation and Injury Management Bill 2023**

(Minister for Industrial Relations) (No. 99)

The purpose of this Bill is to provide for employers to be liable to compensate workers who suffer injuries from employment; and to establish a scheme for compulsory insurance against that liability; and to provide for the management of those injuries; and to provide for the resolution of disputes; and to make administrative and other related provisions; and to make consequential and related amendments to, and repeals of, various written laws.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

### **Major Events Bill 2023**

(Minister for Tourism) (No. 97)

The purpose of this Bill is to facilitate and regulate the holding and conduct of major events in Western Australia; and to make consequential and related amendments to other Acts; and for related purposes.

Consideration in detail of Legislative Council Message No. 99.

Amendment No. 1 agreed to and the Legislative Council acquainted accordingly.

### **Appropriation (Recurrent 2023-24) Bill 2023**

(Treasurer) (No. 110)

The purpose of this bill is to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the recurrent services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 2024.

Declared an Urgent Bill and debated cognately with the Appropriation (Capital 2023-24) Bill 2023.

Second reading debated and agreed.

Referred to Estimates Committees A and B.

### **Appropriation (Capital 2023-24) Bill 2023**

(Treasurer) (No. 109)

The purpose of this bill is to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2024.

Declared an Urgent Bill and debated cognately with the Appropriation (Recurrent 2023-24) Bill 2023.

Second reading debated and agreed.

Referred to Estimates Committees A and B.



**Young Offenders Amendment Bill 2023**

(Minister for Corrective Services) (No. 108)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Young Offenders Act 1994*.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and adjourned.

**Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel National Law Application) Bill 2023**

(Minister for Transport) (No. 114)

The purpose of this bill is to apply a national law relating to marine safety for domestic commercial vessels as a law of the state; and to make consequential and other amendments to the *Western Australian Marine Act 1982*; and to make consequential amendments to various other Acts; and for related purposes.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and adjourned.

**Land Tax Assessment Amendment (Build-to-Rent) Bill 2023**

(Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Finance) (No. 112)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Land Tax Assessment Act 2002*.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and adjourned.

**Corruption, Crime and Misconduct Amendment Bill 2023**

(Attorney General) (No. 113)

The purpose of this bill is amend the *Corruption, Crime and Misconduct Act 2003* and to make consequential amendments to various Acts.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and adjourned.

**Liquor Control Amendment (Banned Drinkers Register) Bill 2023**

(Minister for Racing and Gaming) (No. 116)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Liquor Control Act 1988* and to make consequential amendments to the *Criminal Investigation (Identifying People) Act 2002*.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered and adjourned.
