## SYNOPSIS OF BILLS

*The following synopsis of Bills dealt with by the Legislative Assembly this week, is intended only to give a brief outline of the purpose of each Bill at the second reading stage of the Bill and the stages it was dealt with in the Legislative Assembly.*

### **Local Government Amendment Bill 2023**

(Minister for Local Government) (No. 103)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the *Local Government Act 1995* and to make consequential and related amendments to other written laws.

Second reading, debated and agreed.

Consideration in Detail.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

### **Government Trading Enterprises Bill 2022**

(Treasurer) (No. 92)

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the purpose and governance of, strategic planning by, and accountability and control of, certain government trading enterprises; and to amend certain Acts consequentially; and for related purposes.

Consideration in Detail.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

### **Guardianship and Administration Amendment (Medical Research) Bill 2023**

(Attorney General) (No. 102)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the *Guardianship and Administration Act 1990* and the *Guardianship and Administration (Medical Research) Act 2020*.

Bill introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered, debate adjourned.
