- (c) When is the next assessment of the performance of the agreement the government has in place with Fairbridge;
- (d) Will the Minister table the capital works projects and their respective stages of progress that formed a part of the original deal with Fairbridge;
- (e) How many staff that work at the various camp schools live in the local communities for which they operate; and
- (f) How many total employees work across the camp schools that come under the control of Fairbridge:
 - (i) Will the minister table the numbers for each site?
