8680.Mr J.N. Hyde to the Minister for Environment

In relation to the impairment of bream fish in Claisebrook Cove, resulting from existing buried contaminants, I ask:

- (a) what information regarding similar contamination of fish using the similarly excavated and contaminated site in Elizabeth Quay/the Esplanade has the Minister or his agencies sought or received;
- (b) will the Minister table that information;
- (c) if not, why not; and
- (d) what guarantees will the Minister give regarding the health of fish entering the intended Elizabeth Quay?

In relation to the freeway widening at Lake Monger, I ask:

- (a) is the Minister aware that the original six lanes of freeway will be expanded to nine lanes plus two railway lines;
- (b) what is the latest information and traffic numbers regarding the increase in traffic since the original freeway was opened; and
 - (i) will the Minister table the latest available traffic figures in comparison to the first available figures; and
 - (ii) if not, why not; and
- (c) what plans, proposals or concepts has the Minister, his departments or agencies considered regarding the creation of noise barriers on the Mt Hawthorn side of the freeway adjacent to residential homes near the Lake Monger/Freeway footbridge?

8682.Mrs M.H. Roberts to the Minister for Police

In relation to the proposed western suburbs police hub:

- (a) when will site works commence;
- (b) has a building contract been let; and
 - (i) if so, on what date was the contract let and who won the tender; and
 - (ii) if not, on what date is it proposed to advertise the contract and on what date is it proposed to close tenders;
- (c) what is the current estimated completion date;
- (d) how many police officers are proposed to be housed at the facility;
- (e) how many other staff are proposed to be housed at the facility;
- (f) how many square metres are proposed for the internal building space;
- (g) how many external square metres are proposed;
- (h) how many parking bays will be provided for police cars;
- (i) how many parking bays will be provided for the private vehicles of police and other staff;
- (j) what lock up facilities, if any, are proposed for the hub;
- (k) how much have WA Police paid for the site;
- (l) who has the money been paid to and on what date was it paid; and

(m) will the Minister table the plans for the police hub?

- (1) On what date did WA Police and the Department of Treasury reach agreement on a draft resource agreement?
- (2) On what date did the draft resource agreement become the agreed resource agreement for this financial year?
- (3) On what date did Police Commissioner Karl O'Callaghan sign the resource agreement that is in place for the current financial year?
- (4) On what date did the Treasurer sign the resource agreement that is in place for the current financial year?
- (5) Did anyone from Treasury draft any part of the draft resource agreement?
- (6) If so, roughly what percentage of the document was drafted by Treasury?

8684.Mrs M.H. Roberts to the Treasurer

- (1) If the Treasurer and WA Police did not reach an agreement on a draft resource agreement by one month before the start of the financial year, did the Treasurer direct WA Police in writing to take specified steps in relation to the draft resource agreement?
- (2) If so, what were those specified steps and what was the date of the Treasurer's correspondence?
- (3) If the Treasurer and WA Police did not reach an agreement on a draft resource agreement by one month before the start of the financial year, did the Treasurer direct WA Police in writing to make specified modifications to the draft resource agreement?
- (4) If so, what modifications were directed to be made and what was the date of the Treasurer's correspondence?
- (5) Will the Treasurer table any correspondence that he sent to WA Police where he made any direction in writing to WA Police to make specified steps or specified modifications to the draft resource agreement?
- (6) Did the Treasurer give approval for the Police to provide a draft resource agreement on a date later than the commencement of the financial year?
- (7) If so, with what date did the Treasurer require WA Police to comply?
- (8) Did WA Police meet that date?
- (9) If not, on what date did Police provide a modified draft resource agreement?
- (10) Were any further directions made by the Treasurer to WA Police for later dates of compliance in providing a draft resource agreement?
- (11) On how many occasions and on what dates was the draft resource agreement returned to WA Police?

- (4) Did the Treasurer at any point refer a draft resource agreement back to WA Police?
- (5) If so, on what dates and what matters or details did the Treasurer ask WA Police to further consider or revise?

- (6) Did WA Police and the Treasurer try to reach an agreement on a resource agreement before the start of this financial year?
- (7) If so, what evidence can the Minister provide of this?

- (1) Did the Treasurer or his office or the Department of Treasury receive any evidence of the Minister for Police having provided approval for the Police resource agreement?
- (2) If so, what was that evidence and on what date was the evidence received?
- (3) Will the Minister table that evidence?
- (4) What was the date of the Minister for Police's approval of the WA Police resource agreement, according to any correspondence received by you, your office or Treasury?
- (5) Will the Minister table a copy of the first draft of the resource agreement?
- (6) If not, why not?
- (7) Will the Minister table a copy of the final resource agreement?
- (8) If not, why not?
