The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Workers Compensation and Injury Management Act 2023.

[Iron Ore Agreements Legislation Amendment Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for State and Industry Development, Jobs and Trade) (No. 184)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Criminal Investigation Act 2006; and amend the Weapons Act 1999; and amend the Young Offenders Act 1994; and make related and consequential amendments to other Acts.

Second reading Agreed

Bill read a third time and presented to the Legislation Council for concurrence.

[Building Services \(Complaint Resolution and Administration\) Amendment Bill 2024](#)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Building Services (Complaint Resolution and Administration) Act 2011.

A Bill to- repeal various obsolete Acts; repeal various obsolete Imperial Acts or provisions of them in so far as they are part of the law of Western Australia; and make minor amendments to various Acts.

Introduced; read a first time.

Second reading; debate adjourned.

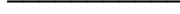
