In relation to the Government's announcement on 24 May 2012 which claims to usher in a new era of country health care in a large part of southern Western Australia, and, in particular, the Minister's statement that Collie will become a key hospital, I ask:

- (b) how many beds will be available in the maternity ward;
- (c) how many birthing suites will be available in the maternity ward;
- (d) will midwifery services be provided 24 hours a day; and
- (e) will a General Practitioner, qualified in obstetrics, be available or on call over a 24 hour period for expectant mothers?

With reference to classroom management in state primary schools:

- (a) what is the State Government's policy regarding personnel being in charge of classrooms whenever a teacher is away on sick leave, at professional development or on release time for:
  - (i) independent; and

  - (i) policy; and
  - (ii) practice?

- (2) What are the potential risks to the public from those travelling with electric bikes on Transperth services?
- (3) Given the obvious benefits to the environment and public health in Western Australia through the increased use of bicycles, including electric bicycles, how does the Department of Transport support electric bike users to access Transperth services if and when they need to?

In relation to government boards and committees, will the Premier provide a list of:

- (a) all active government boards and committees;
- (b) the names of those people serving on these boards and committees;
- (c) when they were appointed and the duration of the appointment; and
- (d) the remuneration, if any, of the appointees?

8226. Mr M. McGowan to the Premier

In relation to the recently completed review by the Public Sector Commissioner into the relationship between the Hon. Peter Collier's ministerial office and the Department of Training and Workforce Development, will the Premier provide a copy of this report to Parliament; and

- (a) if yes, when will it be tabled; and
- (b) if not, why not?

8227. Mr M. McGowan to the Premier

In relation to the use of contracted staff in ministerial offices, will the Premier provide the Legislative Assembly with a list of those people who spend some part of their working week in Ministerial offices but whose names do not appear on the tabled ministerial staffing lists and, if not, why not?

8228. Mr M. McGowan to the Minister for Regional Development

- (1) Can the Minister confirm that legislation is being prepared which will remove the independent regional agency status from existing Regional Development Commissions, and which

provides for these agencies to become regional offices of a centralised Department of Regional Development?

(2) When will this legislation be introduced into the Parliament?

(3) Under the proposed legislation:

- (a) will the local regional boards be abolished or restructured;
- (b) what role will local government have in the appointment of board members;
- (c) how will the staff of the regional offices be appointed and to whom will they be responsible; and
- (d) what role will the local regional offices play in promoting, selecting and monitoring grants available to the local communities?
