874. Dr D.J. Honey to the Minister for Health:

I refer to the matter of teenage pregnancies over the past five financial years to 2022-23, and ask:

- (a) Would the Minister provide data for pregnancies of girls under 16 by region for each year; and
(b) Would the Minister provide data for births where the mother is under 16 by region for the past five years?

875. Dr D.J. Honey to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Finance:

I refer to stamp duty for property transaction for each of the past five financial years, including 2022-23, and ask:

- (a) How many property sales attracted the foreign buyer duty in each year and what was the total foreign duty revenue for each year;
- (b) How many of those foreign buyer transactions involved off the plan property for which stamp duty and foreign buyer tax surcharge are rebated;
- (c) How much revenue was foregone for each year for the rebates for foreign buyers of off the plan properties;
- (d) How many off the plan properties were bought by domestic buyers in each year; and
- (e) How much revenue was foregone for each year for the rebates for domestic buyers of off the plan properties?

876. Dr D.J. Honey to the Minister for Police:

I refer the Minister to the matter of sexual assault of minors over the past five financial years, including 2022-23, and ask:

- (a) How many individuals were charged with statutory rape of a girl under 16 in each year for each region;
- (b) How many individuals were charged with any other sexual assault offences against a girl under 16 in each year for each region; and
- (c) How many individuals were charged with any sexual assault offences against a boy under 16 in each year for each region?

877. Mr P.J. Rundle to the Minister for Education:

I refer to Home Education in Western Australia and I ask:

- (a) In the school years 2019-2023 and according to the Department of Education's Semester One and Semester Two census data:
 - (i) How many students were/are registered as being educated at home for academic years 1-12; and
 - (ii) What was/is the department's Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) allocation to home education moderation in each of the years 2019-2023?

878. Mr P.J. Rundle to the Minister for Education:

I refer to the School for Isolated and Distance Education and I ask:

- (a) In the the school years 2019-2023, and according to the Department of Education's Semester One and Two census data:
 - (i) How many students were enrolled with the School of Isolated and Distance Education (SIDE) by the academic years K-12; and
 - (ii) How many of those students were receiving their SIDE online learning from a Western Australian Education Department site and in which education region?
