2562. Ms L. Mettam to the Minister for Sport and Recreation:

I refer to the recent One Day International cricket match between Australia and England at Optus Stadium on 28 January, and I ask:

- (a) what measures were used to market this event to the United Kingdom;
- (b) how much did the marketing campaign cost;
- (c) how many times was Perth mentioned in the promotional material; and
- (d) how is the success of this marketing campaign measured and what return on investment was achieved?

2563. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:

I refer to your answers to Question on Notice 845, and ask:

- (a) has the Fair Work Ombudsman made findings that security guards, contractors and/or other staff at the Art Gallery of WA were underpaid their employee entitlements:
 - (i) if yes to (a), how many individuals were underpaid;
 - (ii) what was the employment status of those individuals;
 - (iii) what was the total value of the entitlements which were underpaid;
 - (iv) who was the employer of the underpaid staff; and
 - (v) has the Fair Work Ombudsman concluded its investigation; and
- (b) do any of Business Risks International (WA) Pty Ltd, East West Guarding Pty Ltd and/or Macxsec WA Pty Ltd continue to provide services as a contractor or sub-contractor to the Art Gallery of WA and if yes, what services are provided?

2564. Ms L. Mettam to the Deputy Premier; Minister for Health; Mental Health:

I refer to the St John Ambulance Annual Report 2016/17, and I ask:

- (a) what were the percentage of calls across all three categories, Priority 1, 2 and 3, that were responded to within the targeted times at the country volunteer sub centres around the State;
- (b) why weren't these response times included in the current annual report despite being included in past years;
- (c) why was this change implemented; and
- (d) will the Minister commit to ensuring this information, specifically related to response times at country volunteer sub centres, is included in future annual reports?

2565. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:

I refer to the education program at the Art Gallery of Western Australia and ask, for each of the past five years can you provide details of:

- (a) how many FTE were employed;
- (b) the job title of each FTE;
- (c) how many teacher preview events were held;
- (d) how much funding has been allocated towards education programs; and
- (e) how many individual schools accessed education programs?

2566. Mr D.C. Nalder to the Premier; Minister for Public Sector Management; State Development, Jobs and Trade; Federal-State Relations:

I refer to the article *Dumas move saves \$1.7m* as published in 'The West Australian Newspaper' on 13 January 2018 where the Premier states 'I wanted to save the taxpayers money and we are saving the taxpayers money – about \$1.7 million', and I ask:

- (a) how did the Dumas House move achieve the \$1.7 million in savings; and
- (b) how much of the \$1.7 million in savings come specifically from your relocation from Hale House to Dumas House?

2567. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

- (1) Can you please provide a list of those areas in Western Australia which have been designated to be used as new cemeteries?
- (2) Has any funding been allocated for the development of new cemeteries and if so, how much funding has been allocated?
- (3) How much funding has been spent towards the development of new cemeteries for each of the past four years?
- (4) When will the designated areas referred to in the answer to question (1), be available for use?

2568. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

In respect of plots at the Karrakatta Cemetery, I understand the Monument Assessment and Advisory Committee considers a range of criteria in deciding which family monuments are to be preserved and which destroyed and note the list of those criteria provided in public information/publications is non-exhaustive:

- (a) can you provide an exhaustive list; and
- (b) if no, can you please provided a list of the relevant criteria?

2569. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

I refer to the ongoing redevelopment and renewal of Karrakatta Cemetery and, noting that redeveloped areas are referred to as "renewal areas", I ask:

- (a) are people who are interested in acquiring a plot in a renewal area advised what this means and if yes, what information is provided; and
- (b) have any concerns been raised that by burying their family members in a renewal site, they will have to walk over other grave sites to visit the final resting place of their family member and if yes, on how many occasions has this matter been raised?

2570. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

I refer to the ongoing redevelopment and renewal of Karrakatta Cemetery, and ask:

- (a) is there a plan and/or time frame for the redevelopment of different areas of Karrakatta;
- (b) has there been a public education / information campaign to inform people about the redevelopment process and if so, please provide details;
- (c) what was the process for cemetery redevelopment before the commencement of the *Cemeteries Act 1986*;
- (d) what constitutes "disrepair" or "poor condition" of a headstone and who determines whether the damage is severe enough to warrant its destruction or whether it must be kept:
 - (i) are family members contacted to discuss the condition of headstones;
 - (ii) how much effort is expended in locating family members; and

- (iii) if you are unable to locate a family member, what happens to the headstone?
Does this process differ if the headstone is in good repair;
- (e) what is the criteria for destruction of a headstone which is in poor condition or disrepair;
- (f) what method is used to remove memorials /headstones which are in disrepair:
 - (i) have any alternative methods of removal been considered; and
 - (ii) if yes to (i), will these methods be implemented in the future, and if so, from what date; and
- (g) how are original burial sites in redevelopment areas physically marked, to enable family members to identify them and if there are no physical markings, is this matter being rectified and from what date will these sites be marked?
