**Questions listed for this sitting: -**

**4016. Mr J.E. McGrath to the Minister for Seniors and Ageing; Volunteering; Sport and Recreation:**

I refer to the return of motorcycle activity at Barbagallo Raceway on 24 August 2018, when the West Australian Sporting Car Club (WASCC) engaged Track Action to conduct a recreational motorcycle training and track day, and I ask:

- (a) Were the Minister and the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries informed and consulted by the WASCC prior to its decision to host this event;
- (b) If yes to (a), given that the recommendations of the Wanneroo Safety Enhancement Options Identification and Assessment report by Hall Technical have not been met in full (as acknowledged by the WASCC):
  - (i) What actions did the Department take in responding to the WASCC's decision to engage Track Action and host the event;
  - (ii) Was the Department aware if a risk assessment process was undertaken and a report prepared for the event which contributed to the basis of the decision-making;
  - (iii) If yes to (ii):
    - (A) Was the Department involved in the risk assessment process;
    - (B) If yes to (A), was the Department satisfied that the preventative and mitigative measures were implemented to manage the risks associated with a motorcycle training and track day in light of the findings and recommendations in the Hall Technical report; and
    - (C) If no to (A), why was the Department not involved in the risk assessment process, especially after its decision in 2016 to instruct the WASCC to cease motorcycle activity at the Barbagallo Raceway; and
  - (iv) If no to (ii):
    - (A) What methods and standards were used to ensure the safety of the event for all involved; and
    - (B) Was the Department involved in this process and satisfied that the event complied with relevant safety standards; and
- (c) If no to (a), how is the Department overseeing the WASCC's decisions in relation to motorcycle activity following the findings and recommendations of the Hall Technical report?

**4017. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the Minister for Police; Road Safety:**

I refer to the recent Road Trauma Trust Account (RTTA) approved budget for 2018/19, and ask:

- (a) how many submissions for RTTA funding were there for 2018/19;
- (b) of the submissions not approved what was the headline title of each submission;
- (c) what are the names of each of the programs included in the 'Road Safety Events Program';

- (d) will the research, policy and evaluation be conducted by the Road Safety Commission or an external third party source;
- (e) what are the names of the groups the Road Safety Commission will be conducting its partnership programs with;
- (f) when will the safety review of the Indian Ocean Drive improvement works commence and when will it report back to Government;
- (g) who will be conducting the safety review of the Indian Ocean Drive improvement works;
- (h) what will be the assessment framework of this safety review;
- (i) when will the tenders be announcement for the speed camera replacement program; and
- (j) what is the anticipated timeline for these tenders and a decision by Government on the awarding of the contract?

**4018. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the Minister for Police; Road Safety:**

I refer to the collection rate of impounded dirt bikes, motor bikes and off-road bikes, and ask:

- (a) how many dirt bikes, motor bikes or off-road bikes were impounded for each of the years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and as of 1 August 2018:
  - (i) how many dirt bikes, motor bikes or off-road bikes impounded in said years were not collected; and
  - (ii) of the percentage of total vehicles not collected for each said years, what percentage were dirt bikes, motor bikes or off-road bikes?

**4019. Mr D.T. Redman to the Minister for Transport; Planning; Lands:**

I refer to the authority the Minister for Lands has to gift crown land to not for profit groups or charity groups for specific purposes in the public interest, and ask:

- (a) since March 2017, has the Minister gifted crown lands to not for profit or charity groups;
- (b) if so, can the Minister list the properties, the group to which it was gifted and the purpose for which it was gifted;
- (c) other than direct gifting of land, is there any other circumstance where the Minister has given what could be considered to be a concession in respect to land parcels to not for profit or charity groups;
- (d) has the Minister authorised sales of land to “for profit” groups for what would be considered to be concessional against the established land value; and
- (e) if so, could the Minister list the properties, the group to which it was authorised and the purpose for which it was authorised?

**4020. Mr D.T. Redman to the Minister representing the Minister for Education and Training:**

I refer to the Minister for Education’s media statement of 13<sup>th</sup> December 2017 titled “Education savings measures to help budget repair” which cites \$64m worth of savings and up to 170 positions affected, and the recent decisions in respect to camps schools and Landsdale school farm, and ask:

- (a) given all the policy changes since this media release, how much is the Minister now expecting to save for the government and how many positions will it affect;
- (b) is the Landsdale school farm still going to receive any resourcing from the State Government following the decision to have Family Support WA manage the facility;
- (c) will the \$250,000 provided to Fairbridge to run the six camp schools be distributed evenly amongst all the camp schools, or will it be provided differentially to the schools based on need;

- (d) will central office services be maintained for the Broome camp school (as has been the case for all camp schools in the past):
  - (i) if yes, what are these resources; and
  - (ii) if not, who will be providing these support services;
- (e) of the total savings provided to Government as outlined in (a), how much can be attributed to cuts in central office services provided to camp schools;
- (f) has due diligence been done on the various camp school sites to ensure they are in a fit for service state to be handed over to a new operator; and
- (g) if not, will you be doing due diligence on the camp school sites?

**4021. Mr V.A. Catania to the Minister representing the Minister for Education and Training:**

In the 2018/19 Budget handed down in 2018, the total allocation for Stage 3 of the build for Carnarvon Community College has been reduced by \$12 million (from \$38.55m to \$26.55m) without any explanation being offered, and I ask:

- (a) what is the explanation for the 30 percent drop between the budgeted \$38.55m, evidently contained in a Business Case prepared between May and October 2016 and the current figures;
- (b) has the scope of the project changed in any way between the 2016 project (ie the subject of the business case) and the current project under construction;
- (c) was any adjustment to the project made based on any decline in the number of students enrolments;
- (d) if there have been no changes to scope or size, when and by whom was the decision made to reduce the scope or size;
- (e) if there have been changes in scope or size, what facilities or capacity have been excluded or reduced by the changes;
- (f) if there have been no changes to scope or size, what errors were made in the original Business Case to so grossly overestimate the project cost;
- (g) on what date or over what period did the Department of Education (DoE) or the Department of Finance (DoF) become aware of the reduced cost for the project;
- (h) how have any changes been communicated to the College and community;
- (i) suggestions were made during the consultation process of stage 3 to incorporate cost saving and additional spaces but the suggestions were declined, will these requests now be accommodated and, if not, why not; and
- (j) given stage 2 of the project has had defects which were not detected at all by DoE or DoF inspections, what improvements will be made to the Government's inspection regime for Stage 3 to ensure value for taxpayer's money?
