### QUESTION WITHOUT NOTICE (Of which some notice has been given)

Hon Ed Dermer to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Premier

I refer to the recently announced resignation of Craig Hynes, Chief Operations Officer of the Fire and Emergency Services Authority, and I ask-

- (1) Under what contract was Mr Hynes employed and what are the termination clauses within Mr Hynes' contract?
  - (2) Should another position not be found within the public sector for Mr Hynes, will Mr Hynes receive a lump sum payout as a result of his resignation?
  - (3) If yes to (2), what is the total amount of this payout?
  - (4) If yes to (2), what are the details and amounts of the component parts of the total amount?
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**I thank the Hon. Member for some notice of this question.**

- (1) Mr Hynes is employed under a contract of employment as per section 56 of the *Public Sector Management Act* 1994. There are no specific termination clauses within the contract, termination provisions of the *Public Sector Management Act* 1994 apply.
- (2) Yes, in accordance with Section 59 of the *Public Sector Management Act* 1994.
- (3) \$196,008 gross.
- (4) The compensation payment comprises \$160,260 salary, \$18,831 superannuation and \$16,917 motor vehicle entitlement.
