

Magistrates Court (Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2012

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Magistrates Court (Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2012*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Magistrates Court (Fees) Regulations 2005*.

4. Regulation 5 replaced

Delete regulation 5 and insert:

5. Exemptions

A fee is not to be charged in respect of —

- (a) an application under the *Restraining Orders Act 1997* for a violence restraining order or to vary or cancel a restraining order; or
- (b) an application under the *Prohibited Behaviour Orders Act 2010* for a prohibited behaviour order or to vary or cancel a prohibited behaviour order.

Magistrates Court Amendment Regulations 2012

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Magistrates Court Amendment Regulations 2012*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

- (a) in paragraph (b) delete “section 4.” and insert:

section 4;
- (b) after paragraph (b) insert:
- (c) the chief executive officer of the department of the Public Service principally assisting the Minister in the administration of the Act.
