

# Leach Highway – Upgrade of High Street between Carrington Street and Stirling Highway

## UPGRADE HIGH STREET TO IMPROVE SAFETY AND TRAFFIC FLOW

### ISSUES

- High Street is currently a four-lane undivided road, with a potentially dangerous mix of heavy vehicles and local traffic.
- The current layout, with a number of local roads and residential accesses directly adjacent to the route, results in congestion and an increased safety risk.
- Unpredictable journey times to and from Fremantle Port are impacting freight efficiency.

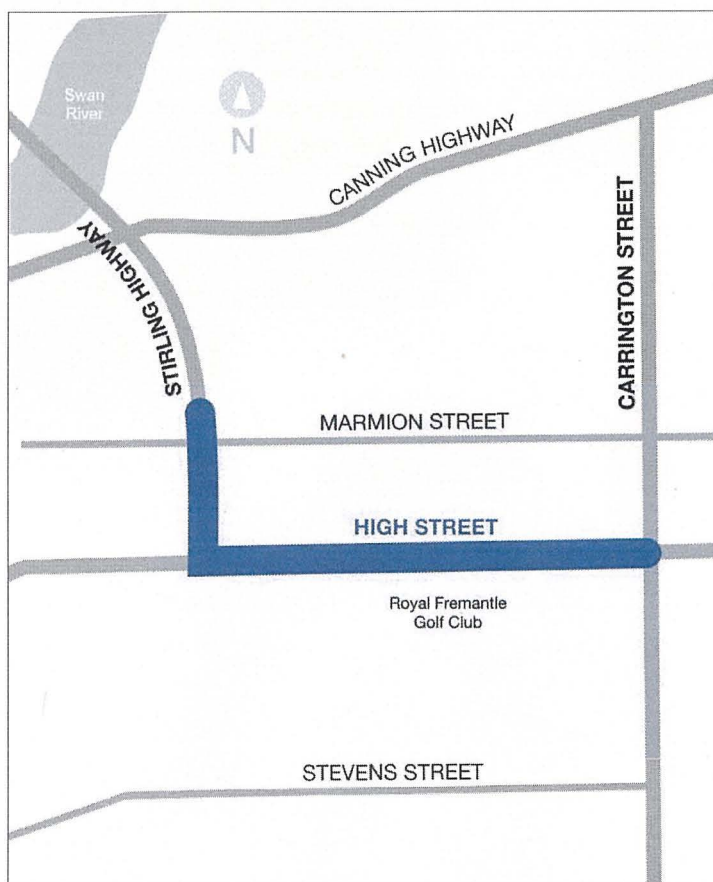
