

Magistrates Court (General) Amendment Rules (No. 2) 2019

Made by the Magistrates Court.

1. Citation

These rules are the *Magistrates Court (General) Amendment Rules (No. 2) 2019*.

2. Commencement

These rules come into operation as follows —

- (a) rules 1 and 2 — on the day on which these rules are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the rules — on the day after that day.

3. Rules amended

These rules amend the *Magistrates Court (General) Rules 2005*.

4. Rule 3 amended

- (1) In rule 3 delete the definition of *courts electronic system*.
- (2) In rule 3 insert in alphabetical order:

ECMS means the electronic case management system for the management of proceedings in Western Australian courts and tribunals;

5. Various references to “courts electronic system” amended

In the provisions listed in the Table delete “courts electronic system” (each occurrence) and insert:
