MAYALA MARINE PARK ORDER 2022

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under section 13(1) and (4) of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

This is the Mayala Marine Park Order 2022.

#### 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day on which this order is published in the Gazette.

# 3. Objects of this order


The objects of the order are to-

- (a) Create the Mayala Marine Park
- (b) Classify the Mayala Marine Park as a Class A reserve.

### 4. Mayala Marine Park reserved and classified

- (1) The area described in Deposited Plan No. 423634 held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority trading as Landgate, is reserved as a marine park, to be known as the Mayala Marine Park, and classified as Class A.
- (2) A copy of Deposited Plan No. 423634 may be inspected during office hours at the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions offices at—
  - (a) 111 Herbert Street, Broome;
  - (b) 17 Dick Perry Avenue, Kensington.
- (4) For information purposes, a representation of the Mayala Marine Park is set out in Schedule 1.
