TABLING OF AGENCIES' 2021-22 ANNUAL REPORTS

Thank you for your letter dated 19 July 2022 regarding the tabling of agencies 2021-22 Annual Report within the prescribed 90-day period after the end of the 2021-22 financial year, as required under section 64(1) of the *Financial Management Act 2006* (FMA).

In accordance with section 65 of the FMA, I wish to advise that I will not be able to table in Parliament the 2021-22 annual report for the Department of Fire and Emergency Services within the prescribed 90-day period after the end of the 2021-22 financial year, as required under section 64(1) of the FMA (i.e. by 28 September 2022).

The Department of Fire and Emergency Services 2021-22 annual report and the opinion of the Auditor General will not be ready for tabling because of the loss of six days preparation time as a result of the last sitting date of Parliament in September 2022 being 22 September. The alternate tabling provisions of the FMA are unable to be effectively utilised in this circumstance for this year.

It is anticipated the annual report will be tabled in both Houses of Parliament on the next sitting date of 11 October 2022.

I hereby request that the Treasurer cause the tabling of this notice in both Houses of Parliament no later than 22 September 2022.
