In accordance with section 65 of the *Financial Management Act 2006* (FMA), I wish to advise that I will not be able to table in Parliament the 2021-22 Annual Report for both the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation (JTSI) and Tourism Western Australia (Tourism WA) within the prescribed 90-day period after the end of the 2021-22 financial year, as required under section 64(1) of the FMA.

JTSI and Tourism WA's 2021-22 annual reports and the opinion of the Auditor General will not be ready for tabling, because of the loss of six days preparation time as a result of the last sitting date of Parliament in September being 22 September 2022. The alternative tabling provisions of the FMA are unable to be effectively used in this circumstance this year.

It is anticipated the annual reports will be tabled in both Houses of Parliament on the next sitting day of Tuesday 11 October 2022, noting this will be dependent on the timing of the Office of the Auditor General's Reports being provided to the agency.

I hereby request that you cause the tabling of this notice in both Houses of Parliament no later than 22 September 2022.
