YAWURU NAGULAGUN / ROEBUCK BAY MARINE PARK (ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES) ORDER 2023

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under section 13(1) and (4) of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

This is the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park (Alteration of Boundaries) Order 2023.

#### 2. Commencement

This notice comes into operation on the day in which it is published in the Government Gazette.


## 3. Inclusion of additional waters in Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park

The boundaries of the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park are altered to include additional waters so that the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park comprises the part of Western Australian waters described in Schedule 1.

# 4. Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park reserved and classified

- (1) The area described in Schedule 1 is reserved as a marine park, to be known as the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park, and classified as Class A.
- (2) The area described in Schedule 1 is shown on Deposited Plan No. 423650, held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority trading as Landgate.
- (3) A copy of Deposited Plan No. 423650 may be inspected during office hours at the Department of Parks and Wildlife offices at—
  - (a) 111 Herbert Street, Broome;
  - (b) 17 Dick Perry Avenue, Kensington.
