CAPL agrees during the Term to:

- (a) use for the Wheatstone Project and the Works:
 - (i) labour resident and available within Western Australia or where that is not available then within Australia, when to do so is commercially practical;
 - (ii) the services of engineers, surveyors, architects and other professional consultants, experts and specialists, project managers, manufacturers, suppliers and contractors resident and available within Western Australia or where that is not available then within Australia, when to do so is commercially practical (including consideration of price, quality, delivery and service);

- (b) ensure that the groups of persons described in clauses 16(a)(i) and 16(a)(ii) are given:
 - (i) full, fair and reasonable opportunity to supply goods and services; and
 - (ii) reasonable advance notice of goods and services that will be required for the Works via a publicly available website that includes reasonable advance notice of proposed contracting requirements together with forthcoming tenders and expressions of interest;

- (c) ensure its contractors comply with the provisions of clauses 16(a) and 16(b);

- (d) submit to the State a report at quarterly intervals from the Commencement Date to the conclusion of construction of the applicable Works, concerning its implementation of the provisions of this clause which:
 - (i) outlines sourcing decisions taken and explains why a Western Australian based bid was not successful;
 - (ii) highlights forthcoming major contracts and indicates the location of the bidders;
 - (iii) provides an ongoing summary of contracts awarded to Western Australian based, Australian based and overseas companies;
 - (iv) provides a description of contracts let within the regions of Western Australia; and
 - (v) provides a similar report to the report described in this clause 16(d) on an annual basis during operational phases of the Wheatstone Project;

- (e) promptly publish the information referred to in clause 16(d)(iii) on a publicly available website; and

- (f) outline and describe in an industry participation plan how CAPL proposes to meet the requirements of this clause 16 that must be:
 - (i) submitted to the State not later than 40 Business Days after the Commencement Date;
 - (ii) regularly updated and maintained during the Term; and
 - (iii) replaced with a new plan:
 - (A) at any time CAPL so elects; and
 - (B) upon reasonable request by the State if in the reasonable opinion of the State the then current plan is inappropriate for the Wheatstone Project and the request is made not less than 5 years after the plan was last replaced.
